

Population of Municipality of Numancia reaches 29, 332 mark (Results from 2010 Census of Population and Housing)



The population of Numancia up by more than five thousand

The Municipality of Numancia posted a total population of 29, 862 persons as of May 2010 Census of Population and Housing. The population size increased by 5, 248 persons over its 2000 population count of 24, 614. The increase in population count from 2000 to 2010 translated to an average annual population growth rate (PGR) of 1.95 percent.

Barangay Bulwang has the largest number of population

Among the seventen barangays (17)comprising the Municipality of Numancia, Barangay Bulwang was the most populous with a size making up 14.0 percent of the total municipal population. Barangay Camanci Norte was the second with 8.3 percent share, followed by Aliputos with 7.1, Laguinbanua East with 7.0, and Dongon East with 6.9 percent. The rest of the barangays contributed 5.7 percent and below. The least populated area was Barangay Tabangka with 3.1 percent share of the total population of the municipality.





Numancia

Pusiw was the fastest growing barangay in population size

Among the 17 barangays, Pusiw was the fastest growing barangay having a population growth rate of 3.68 percent. This growth is almost twice the rate of the municipal level (1.95 percent) and more than double the rate of the provincial level (1.73 percent). Following

Pusiw is Brgy. Aliputos with 3.13 percent, Bubog with 2.50 percent, Bulwang with 2.46, and Tabangka with 2.34 percent.

On the other hand, barangays with slowest population growth rate are Poblacion (0.39), and Badio (0.50).



Average household size stands at 4.6 persons

The number of households in 2010 was households compared with 4, recorded 6, 462 higher by 1, 570 892 households posted in 2000.

The average household size of Numancia in 2010 is 4.6 persons, lower than that in 2000 which is 5.0 persons.

Children aged 15 to 19 years comprised the biggest group of Numancia's populace

As of 2010, children aged 15 to 19 dominated the municipality with 9.97 percent share of the total household population. This was followed by 10 to 14 years old with 9.74 percent, and 0 to 4 years old with 9.70 percent. This made the age structure of the household population of Numancia to deviate from the usual pyramid shape, as population decreases so age increases.

Of the 29, 849 household population in 2010, there were about 8, 648 or 29.1 percent

Sex ratio was 102 males per 100 females

Of the 29, 849 household population in 2010. males accounted 50.4 percent while females comprised 49.6 percent. These figures resulted in a sex ratio of 102 males for every 100 females. In 2000, male population slightly outnumbered thier female counterparts with a

under 15 years of age. Children below 5 years old, as well as 5 to 9, and 10 to 14 years old comprised 9.7 percent, respectively.

In terms of the distribution bv age and sex. males outnumbered females in age groups 0 to 14, and 25 to 49 years old, while females dominated males in the age group 15 to 24, and 50 years old and over.



Children under 15 years old had a sex ratio of 111 males for every 100 females, while for those aged 15 to 64 years had a sex ratio of 102 males for every 100 females. However, the sex ratio for the age group 65 years old and over was 67 males per 100 females, showing a higher mortality of males than females in this age group.

Numancia's school age population accounted 38.7 percent

In 2010, the school-age population (5 to 24 years old) in Numancia comprised 38.7 percent of the 29, 849 household population. By comparison, the school-age population in 2000 was 42.6 percent of the 24, 607 household population. Of the population who were of school age, the males made up 51.1 percent, while females comprised 48.9 percent.



Dependency ratio of Numancia was 55

The overall dependency ratio of Numancia was 55, which indicates that for every 100 working-age population, there were about 55 dependents. This is lower than the dependency ratio in 2000 recorded at 65 dependents per 100 workingage population.

Median age increases to 25 vears

In 2010, the median age of Numancia population was 25 vears, which means that half of the household population was younger than 25 years. This further shows that Numancia has predominantly young population. The 2010 median age is higher than the median age of 22 years recorded in 2000. The municipality's median age for males in 2010 is 24 years, while that for females is 26 years.

In Numancia, senior citizen comprised 9.4 percent of the total household population in 2010, which is higher than the 8.3 percent recorded in year 2000. Among the senior citizens, females outnumbered the males with 57.4 percent and 42.6 percent, respectively. Ageing index in Numancia recorded at 21.4 percent

In Numancia, the ageing index or the proportion of persons aged 60 years and over per 100 persons under the age of 15 years was computed at 21.4 percent in 2010. This means that there are 21 persons aged 60 years and over for every 100 children under 15 years old. In 2000, the ageing index is lower computed at 17.5 percent.

TECHNICAL NOTES

Growth rate – the amount of increase that a specific variable has gained within a specific period and context

Total population – all usual residents of the country or all person present in the country at the time of census.

Household – is a social unit consisting of a person or a group of persons who sleep in the same housing unit and have common arrangements in the preparation and consumption of food.

Household population – refers to all persons who are members of the household.

Average household size – is the average number of persons who live in the household, computed as the household population in a given area divided by the corresponding total number of households in that area.

Median age – is the age that divides the population into two numerically equal groups, that is, half of the population are younger than this age and the other half are older.

Sex ratio – is the number of males per one hundred females in a given population.

Overall dependency ratio – is the number of persons under 15 years old (young dependents) and persons aged 65 and older (old dependents) per one hundred persons 15 to 64 years old (working-age group).

Ageing index – is calculated as the number of persons 60 years old and over per one hundred person under the age of 15 years.

The 2010 Census of Population and Housing (2010 CPH) was undertaken by the Philippine Statistics Authority (formerly National Statistics Office) in May-June 2010 pursuant to Batas Pambansa Blg. 72 and Commonwealth Act 591. The 2010 CPH was designed to take an inventory of the population and housing units in the Philippines nationwide and to collect information about their characteristics. Information on the count of the population and living quarters were collected with 12:01 a.m. of May 1, 2010 as the census reference time and date.

The population counts proclaimed by the President as official for all purposes were based on census guestionnaires accomplished by the enumerators all over the country. Zuestionnaires were processed in Census Processing Centers using the Optimal Mark Recognition (OMR) technology along with the Census Integrated Processing System developed by NSO.
