# **AKLAN VITAL STATISTICS: 2011**

#### **Explanatory Text:**


Vital statistics are registration-based statistics derived from registered birth, death, fetal death, and marriage documents. The data on vital statistics presented in this release were obtained from the copies of the certificates submitted to NSO-Aklan from the 17 Local Civil Registry Office. Figures include vital events that were registered late.

#### BIRTH

#### **Number of Registered Live Births**

The total registered live births of the Province of Aklan for the year 2011 reached to 10, 249. Of this number, 5, 378 or 52.47% were males and 4, 871 or 47.53% were females. Male births are higher by 4.94% equivalent to 507 registered births.






#### Municipality with highest Registered Live Births

Among the 17 Municipalities in Aklan, Kalibo got the higest registration of birth with 4, 108 or 40.08%. Male births comprised more than a half of the total registration with 2, 199 or 53.53%, while females shared only a 46.47% or 1, 909 births. The highest birth registration in Kalibo can be attributed to its being a capital town of the province, where more medical facilities are available. Following Kalibo is the Municipality of Malay with 1, 107; Ibajay with 748 and New Washington with 530 birth reported.

On the other hand, the Municipality of Lezo has the lowest birth registered at 157 or 1.53%. This is followed by Numancia with 218 and Madalag and Tangalan with 238, respectively. It must be noted that Lezo is considered the smallest town in the province having the least number of population, while Numancia being adjacent to Kalibo has most of its expectant mothers preferred to give birth in the capital town.



#### Month with highest registered birth


The month of October registered the highest number of birth with 968 while the lowest birth registered falls on February with 720. November and December shared the same number with 958 making them the second highest period in birth occurrence.


#### Attendant at birth

Of the total number of registered birth in Aklan, the birth attended by physician has the highest frequency with 4, 111 or 40.11%, closely followed by hilot with 3, 996 or 38.99%. However, births attended by midwife have only 1, 953 or 19.06%, while by nurse with 123 or 1.20%. This implies that most of pregnant women in Aklan give preference to physicians in attending to their birth delivery for health and safety reasons. However, there are still those obliged to seek attendance of hilots due to either remoteness of the place, availability of attendant at birth, or due to economic reasons.

#### Daily Average of birth occurrence

The daily average of birth occurrence in Aklan for 2011 is approximately 28 births.





#### Age group of mother

During the year 2011, most of mothers in Aklan gave birth at the age of 20-24 as illustrated in Table 4. Among the age group, this age bracket registered a highest figure at 2, 886 or 28.16%. This is followed by mothers aged 25-29 years old with 2, 646 or 25.82%, and aged 30-34 with 1, 993 or 19.45%. Noticeably, as the age gets older, birth occurrence decreases.


Likewise, the data also show that there are minor mother who gave birth at the age of less than 15 years old with 10 births, and age 15-19 years old with 974 total births.

#### Legitimacy of children


Of the 10, 249 registered births for 2011, 5, 295 (51.66%) are legitimate, while 4, 954 (48.34%) are illegitimate. The Municipality of Buruanga has the highest percentage of illegitimate children at 55.60%, followed by Tangalan with 55.46%, and Malay 54.57 mark. On the contrary, the municipalities with highest percentage of legitimate children registered are Libacao with 60.40%, Kalibo with 55.60% and Lezo with 54.14%



## MARRIAGE


#### Number of Registered Marriage

The total registered marriage in the year 2011 is 2, 890 or an average of eight (8) marriages a day. Of this number, Kalibo has the highest recorded marriage of 447, next in rank is Malay with 336, and Ibajay with 265. The least among the municipalities is Lezo with only 68 reported marriages for the year.



#### Most favored months for marriage

During the period in review, the month of May is the most favored month for marriages with 489 marriage reported. This figure translates to an average of 16 marriages a day. The frequency is concomitant to the fiesta season and other events celebrated during this period. Next favored month is December with 346, and June with 336. November is the month with the lowest registered marriage recorded at 102, or an average of 3 weddings a day.




#### Marriage by Type of Ceremony

Most marriages for the year 2011 were solemnized under Roman Catholic Church rites with 1, 552 or 53.70%, followed by a civil ceremony with 1, 140 or 39.45%, and other religious rites such as Protestants with 189 or 6.54%. Whereas, Tribal and Muslim weddings have the least number of ceremony held having 1 and 5 marriages, respectively.




# DEATH


#### Total registered death

The total number of registered death in the year 2011 pegged at 3, 621. Of this number, male deaths outnumbered female deaths having a total of 2, 129 or 58.80%, while the latter has only 1, 492 or 41.20%. Male death occurrences are higher by 29.92% than that of female.



The Municipality of Kalibo has the highest reported death incidence with 1, 265. Out of this number, 762 are males and 503 are females. Following next is Ibajay with 285, New Washington with 221 and Malay with 217. On the other hand, Buruanga and Lezo have the lowest death cases with 73 and 75, respectively.





#### Average death per day

On the average, there are a total of 10 cases of death reported every day. The month of October registered the highest number of death cases with 338 or 11 death occurrences per day, followed by November with 336 and April with 335. Whereas, December has the least number of death cases with 239 or an average of 8 death occurrence daily.


