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AKLAN VITAL STATISTICS: FEBRUARY 2012

Explanatory Text:

Vital statistics are registration-based statistics derived from registered birth, death, fetal death, and marriage documents. The data on vital statistics presented in this release were obtained from the copies of the certificates submitted to NSO-Aklan from the 17 Local Civil Registry Office. Figures include vital events that were registered late.

BIRTH


More Males than Females are Born

The total registered live births in the Province of Aklan for February 2012 reached to 425. Of this number, 226 or 53.18% were males and 199 or 46.82% were females. Male births are higher by 27 which means that for every 100 female births there are 114 male born in Aklan for this month.


The average daily birth occurrence in Aklan for February 2012 is approximately 15 births.

Municipality with Highest Registered Live Births

Among the 17 Municipalities in Aklan, Kalibo, being the town capital, obtained the highest registration of birth with 186 or 43.77%. Ibajay and Malay followed with 36 or 8.47% and 25 or 5.88% registered births, respectively.




These two municipalities are the biggest in terms of number of population. On the other hand, Malinao had the lowest birth registration this month with only 7 births reported.



Attendant at birth


Out of 425 total registered live births in February 2012, births attended by physician has the highest frequency of 182, followed by hilot with 165, while by midwife with 73, and by nurse with 4.

Based on the daily average of birth occurrence this month, about 6 were attended by medical doctor, thus showing preference by expectant mothers to medical doctors as attendant at birth.



Legitimate Children outnumbered the Illegitimate

Of the 425 registered births for this month, children born legitimate outnumbered those illegitimate. Legitimate recorded at 224 or 52.71%, while illegitimate at 201 or 47.29%. This means that for every 10 legitimate children there are about 9 illegitimate born for this month. The Municipality of Kalibo has the highest percentage of illegitimate children at 37.31%, followed by Ibajay with 10.95% and Malay with 8.96% mark. On the contrary, the municipalities with highest percentage of legitimate children registered are Kalibo (49.55%), Tangalan (6.70%) and Ibajay (6.25%).



Age group of mother


For the month of February 2012, most of mothers in Aklan gave birth at the age of 20-24 years old having the highest frequency of 123 or 28.94%. This shows that three (3) out of ten (10) babies were cared by mothers in this age bracket. While, about 36 or 8.47% live births were born to mothers with age 15-19 years old.

MARRIAGE

Ibajay Dominates Number of Registered Marriage

The total registered marriage for February 2012 reached to 402 or an average of thirteen (13) marriages a day. Of this number, Ibajay has the highest registration with 251 or 62.44%, followed by Madalag with 29 or 7.21%, and Kalibo with 24 or 5.97%. Ibajay got the highest number of marriages this month due to the mass wedding sponsored by the municipal government in cooperation with the NSO-Aklan. It was, so far, the biggest mass wedding held in Aklan.

The least among the municipalities are Buruanga and Lezo with only 2 reported marriage, respectively.



Age of Groom and Bride


Table 6 shows that this month, both grooms and brides preferred to get married at the age of 25-29. Grooms comprised 33.08% (133), while brides 34.58% (139) in this age bracket. However, more brides get married at the age of 20-24 (31.09%) than the groom, white grooms outnumbered brides at the age (3) 34 (24.38%). Conversely, teen brides comprised of 31 or 7.71%, which is ten times more than the number of the grooms (3 or 0.75%).

DEATH

Males Died Faster than Females


For February 2012, the total registered death posted at 275. More than half of the number were males with 153 or 55.64%, while females had 122 or 44.36%.

On the average, there are 9 daily death recorded for this month with a sex ratio of 125 male deaths for every 100 females.




Kalibo has the Highest Death Occurrence

Among the municipalities, Kalibo had the highest reported death incidence with 98 or 35.64%. Out of the total, male deaths shared about 61.22%, while female deaths covered the remaining 38.77%. Batan and Ibajay followed with 38 or 6.55%, respectively. Lezo and Malinao had the lowest death registration with 5 or 1.82%



Death by Age group

More than half of the registered death in Aklan belonged to age group 60 and over with 186 or 67.64%. This was followed by age 55-59 with 16 or 5.82% and age 45-49 with 13 or 4.73%. Both male and female shared the same age bracket with highest death occurrences. Likewise, the data showed that percentage of death occurrences started to increase at the age of 40 and above.



Cardiac Arrest is the Leading Cause of Death in Aklan

Cardiac arrest top the list among the 10 leading causes of death in Aklan, followed by pneumonia and hypertension. Of the total registered death, 243 or 88% were medically attended and 32 or 12% were not attended by doctors.


